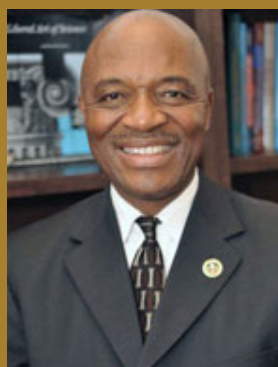

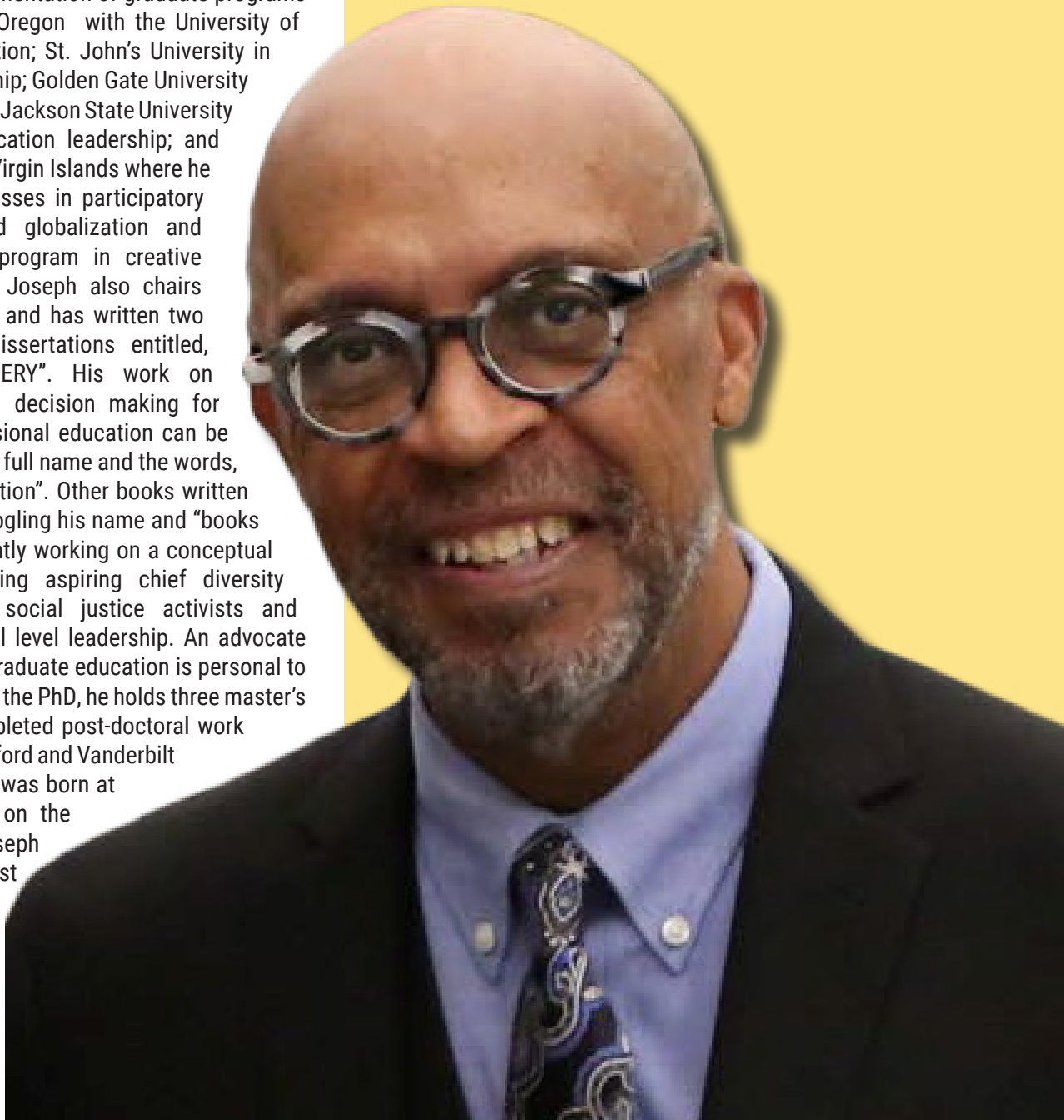

# JOSEPH MARTIN STEVENSON

## ■ Keynote Speaker

Joseph Martin Stevenson has been a pioneer in graduate and professional education for decades. He is presently the Founding and Emeritus Provost for the Global Digital Academy with Class2Class.com in Silicon Valley. Joseph's past work has included the incubation and implementation of graduate programs at the University of Oregon with the University of Guam in K-12 education; St. John's University in urban school leadership; Golden Gate University for an executive MBA; Jackson State University in urban higher education leadership; and the University of the Virgin Islands where he currently teaches classes in participatory action research and globalization and education for PhD program in creative leadership. For UVI, Joseph also chairs several dissertations and has written two books on writing dissertations entitled, "INQUIRY" and "QUERY". His work on applying data driven decision making for graduate and professional education can be found by googling his full name and the words, "An Academic Innovation". Other books written by Joseph can be googling his name and "books by". Joseph is presently working on a conceptual framework for training aspiring chief diversity officers and other social justice activists and advocates in doctoral level leadership. An advocate of lifelong learning, graduate education is personal to Joseph. In addition to the PhD, he holds three master's degrees and he completed post-doctoral work at Harvard, Yale, Stanford and Vanderbilt in Nashville where is was born at Meharry and raised on the campus of Fisk. Joseph is a trained futurist and is considered a thought leader in the HBCU space and clerisy.
